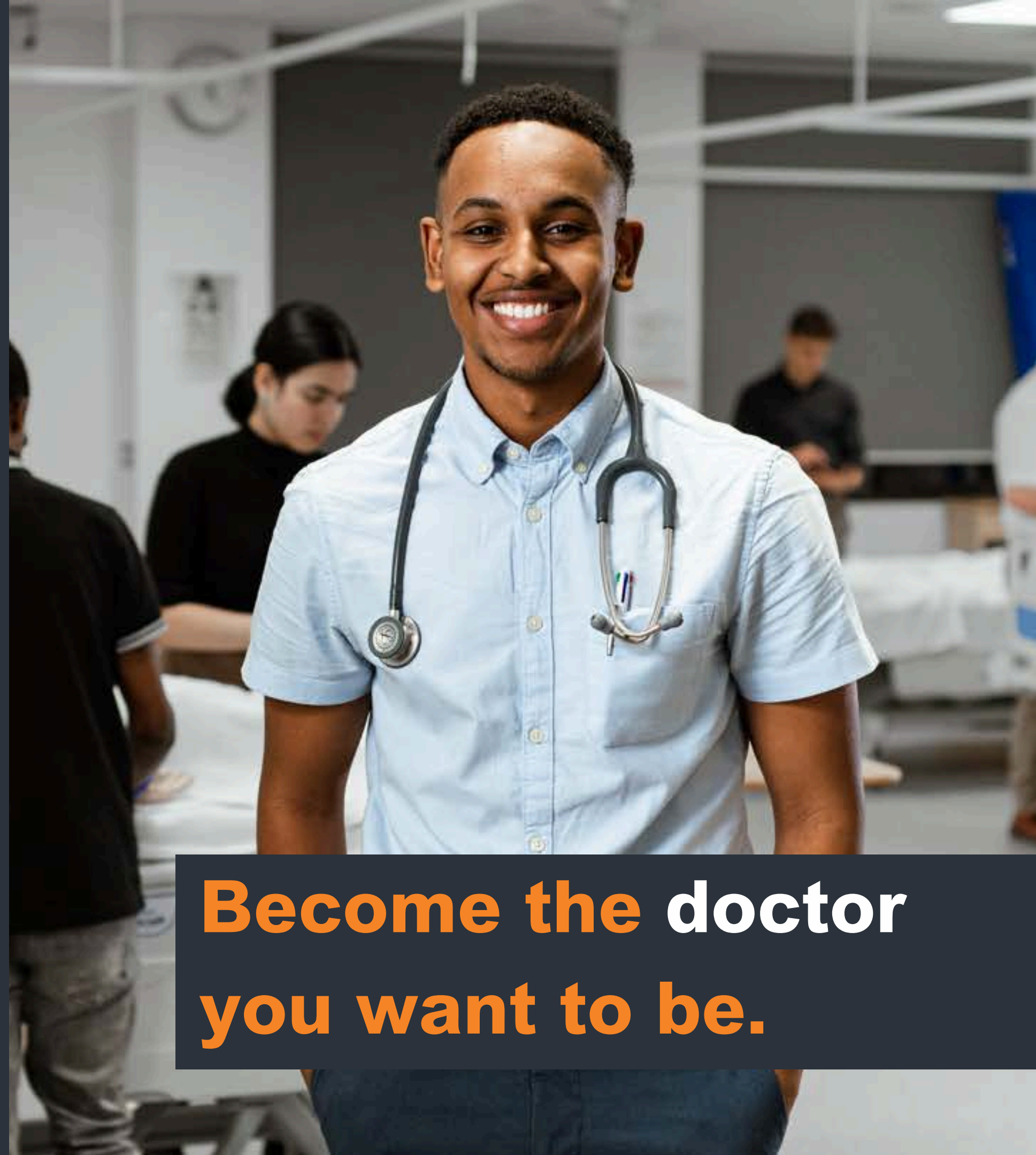

Admissions Appointments

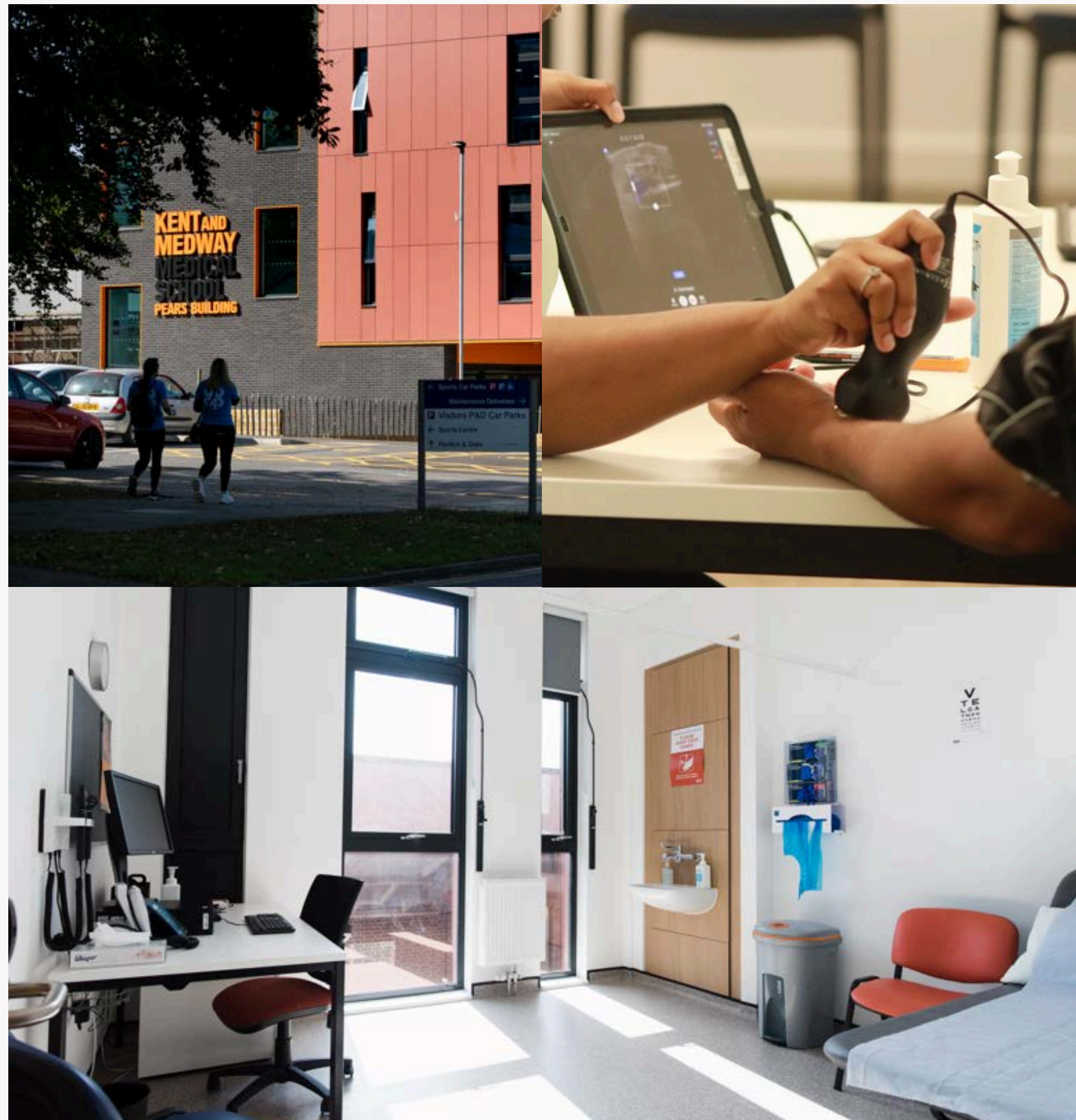
We will also have an extra slots available at Pears with Dr Chan for admissions appointments. If you would like to request a slot please visit the reception at Pears.
